Bail Out by Jade Chandler is book one in her Brotherhood Bonds series which is a spin-off of her Jericho Brotherhood series. I was really excited to read about a female bounty hunter. Unfortunately, I struggled to finish this one.

Hunting satisfied me in a way nothing had since I joined the Brotherhood.

Elle's a bounty hunter for her father's company, and she's trained to take over the business. Her father, however, has other plans. He wants grandchildren, and he's determined to get them. Even if it means making a deal with his daughter that she can't hope to meet.

Rebel is trying to make a name for himself in the bonds business, but his competition is taking his game. Before he knows it, Rebel's in over his head with a female bounty hunter who may just be his match. But Rebel isn't looking for love...

The female bounty hunter aspect initially peaked my interest. I wanted to see a woman on top in this blue-collar field, kicking butt and taking names to bring these criminals in. The first half exceeded my expectations. I loved Elle's determination, and she really gets blindsided by her father. Image training all of your life, competing with men day-in and day-out to make a name for yourself, only to potentially lose it all. She needs to do the impossible to have a chance at keeping her business.

So far so good.

I enjoyed Rebel too. Rebel's found acceptance in the MC brotherhood, and he doesn't want to let them down. He needs his bond business to take off. The wind is knocked out of him by bombshell, Elle. Watching these

two work together was great. Rebel's a good guy hero biker, but still has that commanding presence. (Total catnip!)

The MC part was really well done too. I have a love/hate relationship with MC stories, but I like how the brotherhood is legitimate (no gun running, drug dealing, etc.). It's a refreshing take, and it sets this book apart.

The last half, however, everything fell apart on me. There's less focus on the bounty hunting aspect that I loved. It would have been okay if the story moved forward at all. Instead, the scenes became repetitive.

Some odd elements come out of left field too. I like how Elle steps out of her comfort zone (boy, howdy!), but a few times something she did--and suggested!--had me scratching my head. I didn't understand the point of it all. It just felt thrown in there for an added scene.

This is also when another element with Rebel comes into play--a not-quite BDSM element. It left me completely flabbergasted on what it even means or how it's essential to the story. It changed nothing.

I think that's what bothers me the most. The characters lost a little of their spark to fit into this mold or new role they're given. It felt forced, and it added nothing to the overall book but take away from the couple's chemistry (or to have more bounty hunting fun!).

If you like alpha bikers, Rebel definitely commands the page. Elle's also a tough cookie. I think it just comes down to a personal preference, and that I just couldn't find the same enthusiasm for the characters in the last half that I did in the beginning.

The Jericho Brotherhood also has a dog in this fight, and Rebel is getting pissed that some woman is stepping all over Brotherhood Bonds' business.

When the two of them go after a big prize, sparks fly immediately, leaving their competition in the dust. Neither of them expected, or wanted, something other than sex, but it may be too late for these two as feelings get deeper than anticipated.

I love the Jericho Brotherhood series, and the first book in the spinoff Brotherhood Bonds series, BAIL OUT, is no exception! Elle and Rebel made one sexy bounty hunting team, and even though he was kind of a manwhore, he treated Elle with much respect and caring. He was the whole package for her...sexy as hell, sweet and a seriously kick ass bounty hunter. This one was 3.5 stars for me. I really liked both main characters, and I love the fake marriage/forced proximity trope, but there were a few things that put me off of giving it a 4-star rating. This is apparently a spin-off of this author's Jericho Brotherhood series, but I didn't feel like I was missing anything vital. This was a standalone story, and it was pretty self-contained.

Elle Jackson is a bounty hunter. It's her family business and it's in her blood. Her daddy owns the business now, and it's been passed down in her family for generations. Her dad is the only family she has, since her mom died giving birth to her, so she's learned the business inside out from the time she was a little girl. She's always had plans to take over upon her dad's retirement. He, apparently, has other ideas. After his heart attack a couple years ago, he's been obsessed with getting Elle married off and her providing him with grandchildren. She has NO interest in that plan, but he's not hearing that. They agree to 2 possible conditions

for her to inherit. One seems impossible. One, her pride won't let her go through with.

Rebel is a member of Jericho Brotherhood MC. He's also the owner of Brotherhood Bonds, and a fellow bounty hunter. When Elle sneaks a bounty out from under him, he's pissed, but also intrigued by her beauty and strength. He's been on his own for a long time, and has no family he associates with except his MC brothers, so he recognizes Elle's predicament, and offers to help her. Neither of them knows what they're getting into. They both vow to not catch any feelings. Famous last words...

Rebel and Elle had a great connection and instant chemistry. I really loved their banter, and their obvious similarities, both in their temperaments, and in their lives in general. They really got each other from the start, even before they really knew one another, and I loved that.
