Andree Bancroft lives on St. Bathelemy and is sheltered by her father and surrounding community who care very much about her. When Maximillian, aka, Lian shows up at his aunt and uncle's vacation home looking for solace away from crazy fans, Lian meets Andree and believes that she is one of his stalker fans and is suspicious of her. He has hard time trusting her even after he finds out that she is the caretaker's daughter.

Personally, I had trouble connecting to either character. Lian is very spoiled and vain, which unfortunately isn't my type of lead man. Andree is sweet and innocent and there are times when I felt that she should walk away from Lian, though she is obviously the kind of woman that he needs. Their awkward meeting and unusual first kiss were too much for me see it as a romance. While the island is beautifully described and I loved the relationship between Andree and her father, I had trouble reading it as a romance. I felt that the romantic build up was lost because each encounter was shown from the wrong perspective. When Lian finally trusts Andree and decides to lean on her, allowing her to see his weakness, the moment is lost because we hear Andree's thought about how nice his arm felt around her.
