Can her background help her quest to finish the dangerous game the Game Master has set out for her?

Detective Caelan Fen is caught in the Game Master's web and little by little he realises that in order for his loved ones to survive, he must help Nessa and try to beat the evil puppet master in his own sport.

I have read most of this author's books and one thing I noticed is that almost all her heroines are tough as nails, flawed but strong just like Nessa. At 31 years old, Vanessa "Nessa" Griffiths wakes up in a strange place and is informed that she is to play this depraved game or else harm will come to her family. Thinking she's escaped the dangers surrounding her childhood, Vanessa quickly realizes she has no choice but to compete in hopes of getting answers and saving those she loves. However, she doesn't expect layers of truth and pain to be revealed along the way.

"This was his way of telling me he knew exactly who I was. I could almost foresee his next step."

Caught off guard, Caelan Fen is thrust into a deadly situation where he finds himself partnered with a stranger. A detective by occupation, Caelan has plenty of enemies but time is of the essence as he tries to crack the game master's cryptic riddles. Caelan is familiar with retribution but he isn't prepared for the level of depravity in the games.

“The sense of my own death loomed in the moments ahead, my fate in the hands of each person following my every move.”

Told in dual POV, the immediate tone is ominous, tense and so much is unknown. Under enormous pressure, the only way to react is to hyper-focus on each game and cast aside fears. Nessa and Caelan are two unlikely partners and as they wonder why they’ve been paired together, complex layers of mysteriously shrouded clues create clarity and the unexpected.

“When I felt the familiar calmness soothe the fury in my veins and steady the beat of my heart, I smiled coldly. “I’m not in the mood to amuse you any more. It’s time to fight for that end square and reveal who is the true Game Master.”

With time ticking, the race for answers is filled with adrenaline induced action and serious consequences. While Nessa and Caelan have secrets they want to keep, the game master makes it impossible and this enhances the potential conflict. Nessa is a strong character who isn’t a stranger to the underworld but returning to that place, she must descend into darkness and embrace valor. Caelan offers a steady balance to the plot but he also carries his own demons which makes him vulnerable.

From the first page, I was intrigued with the circumstances affecting these characters. As more is revealed, the psychological thriller aspect is heavy but there is also emotion tied into motivations and choices. With two carefully constructed characters and a devious Game Master, the plot is diabolically propelled up to the final square of game. In true DH Sidebottom fashion, the evolution of the characters is fitting.

Game Master is a dark psychological thriller that will keep the reader engrossed to the very last word. I highly recommend to those who are open to all possibilities.

It's not often that a story leaves me speechless. This was a psychological thriller that left me in a perpetual state of nervous apprehension from beginning to end. High octane all the way. The mystery-suspense elements were almost more than I could handle as Nessa and Caelan, two supposed strangers, solve clues and riddles that put their lives and those of their families at stake. To stay in the game, the pair must solve a daily task to live to see another day. Failure to solve the day's task, the game ends, permanently.

Good time to mention that this is a dark themed story. Dark as in the subject matter includes violence, blood letting, and abuse. This isn't for the faint of heart but does provide a totally satisfying experience for those who enjoy stories that are intended to shock and thrill readers with the added suspense-mystery to ponder. Yup, the total package.

The world building was spot to maximize the plot/story line. Just enough details to support the premise of this story without going too far into over dramatizing the cat and mouse situations as they evolve. Not going to mention anything more as this is a new release and giving anything away may spoil the reading experience for potential readers.

I'm going to mention that while this does primarily land under psychological mystery-suspense thriller there is a romantic suspense slant that does not include any intimate adult content romance scenes. Frankly, with all that's going on and with the ongoing 'game' premise, nope. Would have been totally unrealistic. Just putting that out there for any who base their reading on the degree of romance.
