So he gives her a choice: he will pay her father's debt if she agrees to stay with him for one week, following his every command....or she can allow her father to face the consequences of his actions (which would be his death, as he cannot pay what he owes).

I fell in love with the characters....especially Emery. She is sassy as all get out and very likeable. She struggles with the fact that she's been kidnapped versus that she chose to stay to save her father. I love the two of them together.
