This is the third book I've read from author A.M. Hargrove and I must say that it gets better each time I pick one of her's up.

I didn't like the first I read, Dark Waltz and then I had various mixed emotions about the first book in this series - Edge Of Disaster.

What improves in this book compared to the first?

The writing style for one. I really liked the way it followed easily in Shattered Edge.
