I can't make up my mind if I sort of liked this book or if it was bad. I choose to give the book 2 stars because there were actually parts that I really liked. Even if there was even more that I disliked, the parts that I liked lifted the enjoyment of reading significantly.

The story is told in first person by Scarlet and Kier. I sometimes have problems with this type of writing because I don't feel like it gives me the best view of things and a lot of surrounding details are either missed or making the character rambling about things that never crosses into normal people's minds. The latter can make a reader lose interest. In addition there can be problems with the character building. Despite being told from their perspective it can be hard to really get to know the characters if the author isn't exceptionally good at this type of story telling.
