Adding a little something to make everyone go into a mating heat, if you try to escape you get a cursed which prevents you from using your paranormal abilities again. They must mate and it must be someone outside their own race. If they don't mate within 24 hours, they will never have a mate.

Asher Deacon is a phoenix shifter; he tries to run to get out of mating. He runs into a sprite named Zaiden Reed. They think they can be mated and lead separate lives. But all is not what it seems, and things are never that easy. Someone wants to kill Asher and have Zaiden all to themselves. Can the two mates save each other and really bond as one?

Fire and Ashe by Gabrielle Evans is third book in the Midnight Matings series. Though part of a series, this book could stand alone. I highly recommend this series. Each book has a different author, who brings a new and fresh perspective to the paranormals involved. In Fire and Ash we meet two very unlikely paranormal characters.

Asher is a smart and cunning Phoenix shifter while Zaiden is an equally quick witted sprite. I thought both men were smart, cunning and completely loveable. A fun story with a fun premise. I like how well Evans integrates each character's paranormal identity with his personality, and with the mysterious stalker plaguing their relationship. I also like that Evans's characters *didn't* read the Elders' handout regarding their forced mating--I'd wondered what would happen physically/emotionally if a couple forgot to read said pamphlet and separated after the conference.

While the magic, main characters, mystery, and sex scenes were well done, they were somewhat undermined by the issue that time (and story length) poses in this story.

First, Zaiden and Asher are 200 and 2000 years old, respectively--yet aside from being secretly rich, each man acts like an average, modern-day twenty-something. History seems to have had no effect on their personalities or beliefs, nor on their ties to others. Based on what we see, neither has close ties with a family or their fellow paranormals. For Zaiden this is explained and understandable. For Asher, I wish there had been an explanation; he seems far too outgoing to have only his roommate in Mexico for a friend.

Second, there were some time-skips in the narrative that I, as a reader, wanted to see rather than hear about after the fact. Given the short story length, however, paired with a mystery *and* the necessity of showing Asher and Zaiden evolving from forcibly-married to married-by-choice, I'm not surprised some things were curtailed. There is one place in particular, though, that took me aback, because a problem between the couple--Zaiden's sudden drunkenness and their distant relationship--seemed entirely out of character given all I'd read thus far, and their closeness at the previous chapter's end. It also seemed too convenient that the night I re-joined them, Asher and Zaiden resolve their month-long (yet sudden to me-as-reader) issue.

All time issues aside, I did enjoy *Fire and Ash*. I also like the premise of the Midnight Matings series--it's a fun arranged-Vegas-wedding sort of idea--and I'll definitely continue reading them.
