I loved Sweet Home Carolina so much, but not only for the obvious hot love story. Darcy and Trent were so good together, hot, cold, angry, frustrated and all the emotions of figuring out exactly what love is – and how the heck you react to something you never planned on. But their story isn't the only one I want to touch on in this review.

This story has a serious side story of girlfriend power. You know the girl code, right? If a guy hurts your girlfriend then all the gaggle of ladies will tar and feather him for her... that's girl power code. There are six, no seven when you count in Darcy in our Magnolia Bay gaggle of girlfriends. Six die hard ladies who have taken in Darcy. Who freely admits that in her past professional or personal life she was a tomboy and never really played nice with the girls but now these girls have got her back. When the Bloom bitches, I mean old biddies, block every attempt to get Mimosa House on the Historical Tours of the Historic Preservation Society, Darcy is facing serious trouble making her dream of opening a Bed & Breakfast in the historic old former brothel. While an ancient beauty, Mimosa House is a black hole money pit and Darcy needs that tour

spot in order to survive. When Trent's father moves the entrance to his gaudy, Vegas styled Golf Resort next to the property line of Mimosa House again threatening Darcy's livelihood, it almost destroys Darcy (and puts a bit of a damper on romance too).

During these heartbreaking, maddening and frustrating moments is when the six super ladies do what girls do best – come to the rescue of a member of the girl power circle. Descending with baskets of wine and food, the ladies take over Darcy's down mood and bring her back to fighting mode – and come up with fantastic ideas as well. Girl power rules – no matter the age. I've read novels (we all have) with a best friend as a dominant secondary character and loved the relationship. This time, with this group of ladies – honestly, they took over the story for me, and I love their part in the overall story.

I'm sorry to say that while Trent was gorgeous, sexy and did things to a tool belt that should be illegal – he took second place to the group of ladies who made Darcy one of their own and brought resolution to most of the story.

Sweet Home Carolina is a beautiful story with so many Southern charms it's hard to list them all. Trent and Darcy will fight themselves and each other over the attraction they have. Unfortunately, Mimosa House comes with an embarrassing history to the Bloom Family, who just happens to run the Historical Society Board, and control the Historical Home Tours. Without being on the Home Tour Mimosa House has virtually no chance of attracting customers...or making money.

Trent Mauldin has just lost his PGA Tour card after failing to recover from a second shoulder surgery. Coming home to work for his father wasn't his preference, but he soon realizes that it's a lot more complicated than he ever could have thought. Big Jack's new resort and golf course might be outside of Magnolia Bay, but the entrance isn't. Now Trent's loyalties are being torn in three: the Bloom Family, to whom he belongs on his mother's side; his father, for whom he works; and the cute redheaded B&B owner, whom he might actually be falling in love with.

This book was a gut punching, emotional roller coaster that I wanted to get off one minute, and ride it out the next. At one point I wanted to laugh, cry, cheer, and throw-up all at once. I swear that the author was looking for ways to torture Darcy over and over again. I wasn't sure a happy ever after was even possible toward the end. The fact that the ending was pulled off was so impressive I actually did cry...with relief.

Overall, this story was so extraordinarily told I will recommend it to everyone I see.

Warning: the author writes in "first person perspective" for the heroine. It takes a bit to switch back and forth, but it doesn't take away from the story. There are a few typos that are noticeable, but again, unless you are a grammar Nazi, it doesn't take away from the story.
