We begin 2 years after Dmitry & Catherine have married and what started as a business arrangement has turned into more. Catherine is dying of cancer. With her daughter Emma gone & no one left that she cares about or that cares about her she leaves everything to her young husband Dmitry, however his newfound wealth and power comes at a price. At the same time Ivan is quickly falling for Arie, the young assassin who works for Dmitry. Arie has plans to break free of her controlling brother, Dorian & the two bond over their shared desire to be free of their siblings. With more money than he could imagine and his list of responsibility growing, Dmitry request help from one of his Vor brethren, Khalid, to deal with Hutton Enterprises.
