In this novella we are introduced to Achaius, Sha's half brother and his mate Saia who play an important role in this book. This book picks up right where it left off in the first one.

Sha is Mythrian and she is a sorceri with the ability to control water and fire. She is impulsive, witty and brave. She landed on earth when the Nexus, a gateway between earth and Mythria was damaged from the use of dark magic.

When Sha is pulled back to Mythria from earth, Connor who is a detective follows her through the tear in the gateway despite not knowing what awaits him on the other side. There they find utter chaos but Sha is relieved to be reunited with her brother Achaius, his mate Saia and her Sentinel partner Luca.
