Ah, this is much better. *Dawn of the Arcana* still struggles with an oversimplified plot and world-building, but based on the last two volumes, the story is starting to feel a little more solid than in previous volumes.

It's good to get a little more history on both Nakaba and her loyal attendant Loki. And, I am glad to see Caesar realize his responsibilities and step up to them instead of hiding behind circumstances.

The artwork is continuing to improve. There are more backgrounds to give foundation to the characters and tone to the setting. Characters still come off as static, but I like the defined styles both in clothing and architecture for the different countries and cultures that we're visiting.

Mangaka, Rei Toma, improves with both style and substance in the last two volumes. I hope to see this trend continue.

This is the type of shoujo manga that makes me like the genre. The heroine, Nakaba, has been discriminated against just because of her hair color (hair color is given the same negative tones and descrimination as skin color is given in the real world which does a good job of bringing to light how silly it is to treat someone differently based on something they're born with and can't control). Her mother, a princess of Senan, ran away to be with the man she loved (why she had to run away to be with him is explained throughout the story) and after her death, Nakaba is brought back to her grandfather, the king. He stows her away in a tower of the castle and that's where she grows up.

In another kingdom, Ceasar is born as the second son to the king of Dequat but because of his black hair and the fact that the eldest son, Cain, is blond, there's hidden deceptions and factions working to make Ceasar the

next king. All Ceasar has wanted is the love of his family though and because of the choices made by the adults in his life, he grows into a young man who has a negative outlook and distrust of people.

To try and prevent war, the kings decide to make a treaty and Nakaba is sent to "seal the deal" to be Ceasar's wife. At this point, two kingdoms who care little of these two as people but only see them as pawns, put them together and - to everyone's surprise and disgust - they start to not only get along but fall in love.

Not only do these two have to deal with the machinations of their kingdoms and the individual discriminations against them but there's also the racism against a separate group of people called Aijin who share traits with various animals and there's also the mysterious powers known as the Arcana that gift their bearers with anything from control of an element to the ability to see the future. (Nakaba has been gifted with the Arcana to see the past and future.)

This series brings together all the good points of a love story with the fantasy saga of two kingdoms who are at war. The heroine has to overcome the discrimination against her, the power she's been given that can be terrible, her growing love for a man she should hate, and fighting for the Aijin. The hero of this tale has to decide to set aside his uncaring attitude and decide what he wants to fight for while he learns what lengths he'll go to and what strength he has for a woman he loves.

This series made me fall in love with the characters, root for their fights and cry for their losses. It has surprises throughout and keeps you just enough off balance that you aren't sure what will happen next. I highly recommend this title to anyone who enjoys fantasy, a relationship between two people who don't immediately care about each other, a strong heroine, or people with animal traits (for lack of a better term, furries).

Why are Lithuanel's princes even more gorgeous than our female protagonist?

Caesar you're my favorite character, and I think hiding in the old you is better.

I feel bad for him actually. He's now the heir to Belquat, and because he loves Nakaba, he's not doing anything but just watch as these sub-people spy from his country and as Nakaba tries to break the alliance of Lithuanel with his own country.

Nakaba changed, but only a little. She can control her arcana now by looking at blood to see visions but I don't like it how she . . . invades other people's privacy by looking at their past just like what she did with Loki's. (view spoiler)

In the earlier chapters than 31, Loki was really mysterious. He is still now but because of Nakaba's privacy-invading-power we got to see some of what happened to Loki.

I'm torn. I like Caesar—and actually my favorite character here—because he's just a normal human. He doesn't have a lot of secrets (unlike Loki), he's strong (unlike *her*), and he went from this, 0 to 100 development. He changed, unlike . . . Anyway, in the first chapter he's just plain b*astard but when his hair became shorter, it was like that attitude left with that hair. The more I read the more I like him.

Loki. The more I saw Loki's past the more I think he'll be better for Nakaba. Because he knows many things about her. He knows she has the arcana and he will protect her no matter what. Caesar barely knows Nakaba. But the more she stays with Loki the more she'll get in trouble.

It just that I think, Caesar is not for Nakaba. They are enemies, and his country will fall down the more he loves her. Remember that she even agreed to keep Loki's plan to earn Caesar's trust and kill him? She can just go with Loki in Senan and forsake Caesar in Belquat, please.
