This is not normally the type of book I read but it was a fun vacation from historical fiction. This is the first book in a trilogy and it's obviously meant to be just a teaser to get you to the other two books. A lot of groundwork and back story is provided to set the tone for what's to come.

It's a fantasy novel so I can't get caught up in the realism of the characters and their reactions to situations, which is probably a good thing. It's fun to just let go and immerse yourself in a completely different world where none of the rules we know mean anything at all.

Luckily for me, I read this book as a book club pick and the author will be visiting group this week. I'm sure I'll be inspired to read the rest of the trilogy after hearing more about her experiences writing these books.

The only caution I have is that I think this is a bit too mature for young audiences who are often drawn to the fantasy genre. There are quite a few explicit 'intimate' scenes between characters that would not be suitable for teens.
