### **Privacy was a quaint, non-existent concept....**

Stella Barcelona's sophomore entry to the mercenary world of Black Raven is solid and scary. She again draws from world events by focusing this book on terrorism, how cells are funded, how they recruit and the role of cyber-communications and hacking in both perpetrating terrorism and ending it. This is a complex book which will require every ounce of your attention.

International Terrorism Tribunal attorney Samantha Fairfax is garnering a lot of attention - from all the wrong people. Teams of lawyers and judges from various countries are under attack from opposing politicians, radicals and hidden terrorists. People are being targeted and dying, and Black Raven partner Zeus Hernandez has been tasked with keeping Sam safe. The two have a history, and Zeus will go to any length to keep the smart and sexy Sam doing her job.

This book is fairly evenly weighted between romance and courtroom thriller. A lot of people do not want to see the Tribunal hearings succeed, and key players are getting picked off almost daily. True terrorist tactics are used, meaning loss of life is a collateral. The extreme danger pushes Sam and Zeus even closer together.

Sam is brilliant and focused, and so is Zeus. They both find this attractive in the other, but it causes them major problems at the same time. Zeus is determined to give them a second chance; Sam is not. If you are a fan of the "pushing away" theme in romance, you will get an overload of it here, but this time from the woman. Unfortunately, this is something in romance novels that I never understand. Separation from the one you love is crippling. Love and support only makes you stronger, and when it is offered, why on Earth would you reject it? Drama, I guess.

Overall, I thought both the romance and the overall plot had peaks and valleys. At one point, bodyguard Zeus lets Sam bind him with his neckties. Hmmm, people are dying, danger is everywhere, you are a guard and you let your client immobilize you during sex? Never gonna happen. On the other hand, Zeus is going bonkers for this woman and it is nice to see the alpha type squirming for once. He's smart enough to know Sam is worth it, and he uses every weapon in his arsenal to sway her. Including handing over control every once in a while.

The thriller part of the novel chips away at the core question of privacy. Essentially, there is no privacy, and the ethics of how and when privacy is violated is approached in a roundabout way. Everyone is susceptible.

For Sam, it boils down to whether she will choose to violate privacy to capture a deadly terrorist. Should certain rights be suspended in order to protect the innocent? That is the dilemma. Barcelona's taut cyber-thriller weaves a hot romance between the intense international lawyer and the determined security contractor, where being smarter and quicker means life rather than death.

Rather, it is intelligently written, making the reader really think, plot and plan right along with the characters so perfectly portrayed within. There were times that the technical dialogue did become drawn-out and might bore those who aren't enamored with all things ITT logistical but the terrorist aspects were timely and intriguing. It never allows the reader to relax as the action and suspense just keeps ratcheting higher and higher!

Samantha's character was the only real glitch in the story. While I understood her initial reticence and actions, as the story progressed her cold, hard, stubborn refusal to show any compassion or feelings at all made it impossible to even like her. It was even more offensive when she used Zeus to satisfy her sexually then treated him so despicably. Yuck! Couldn't even bring myself to root for her in the end. "Jigsaw" by Stella Barcelona is part of the 'Black Raven' series and explores the functioning of the International Terrorist Tribunal when it has to deal with a rash of terrorist attacks and endeavors to link it with the greatly feared Maximov organization. Samantha (Sam) Dixon Fairfax is tasked with the prestigious, and ultimately, dangerous, role of serving on the Amicus Curiae team but the biggest challenge she faces is dealing with Jesus (Zeus) Hernandez and keep him from breaking her heart again. Zeus utilizes his formidable skills and highly elite team to keep Sam alive, but only he can fight the most important personal battle of his life...if he can stay alive long enough to make his case.

This contemporary romantic suspense story is an exciting and spellbinding tale of terrorism, politics, and global cooperation with a delicious counterpoint of lost love and dedication to ethics and the requirements of the job, no matter how unpalatable. I love the intense characterization, the political chess game and legal maneuvering, and the beautiful devotion displayed by Zeus. There are some elements that aren't as cleared up as I would have liked about the way things turn out but I certainly enjoyed the 'aww' moments and the breathless anticipation as the danger ramped up. Those who are squeamish should be advised that there is graphic violence and those who are impatient should be warned there are definitely crossed wires and frustrating lack of communication. The overall story is wonderfully crisp and covers a multitude of locations and challenges and provides a look at some of the other intriguing Black Raven folks, with cameos by the primaries from the prior book. This series is a thought-provoking and thrilling read thus far and I definitely look forward to reading more about the sexy and extremely capable members of Black Raven.

Jigsaw changes the pace from previous books and becomes a intense political thriller centered around International Terrorism Tribunal, a court convened to combat terrorism after multiple deadly terrorist attacks around the world.

This is also what I would categorize as a smart thriller because you really need to pay attention as there is a lot going on. It has a large cast of characters including the President and his close advisers.

One of the reasons ITT was formed was to establish a link between the current terrorist acts and a terrorist organization headed by Maximov-in-Exile, a terrorist that has eluded the world and become known as a ghost as no one has seen him in years. When the Chief of the U.S. Amicus Curiae is allegedly murdered, Samantha Fairfax is appointed the new leader and Black Raven Security is called in as her personal protection by her grandfather.

Zeus Hernandez works Ciber for Black Raven and rarely does personal protection anymore but when Samuel Dixon personally asks for Zeus to head up his granddaughters protection detail he knows he wont be able to refuse due to their past history. Samuel's strong belief that members of the ITT are being targeted for death and Zeus unresolved feelings for Samantha from 7 years ago pretty much make it to where he cant say no.
