I have read and loved several books by Ms. Fossen but had not read any of her romantic suspense. Wow! I've been missing some amazing stuff! There's nothing like the dynamics between two people who find themselves thrown together against a common enemy, especially when there's an attraction there.

DEA agent Cord Granger is certain the man he has in custody, his biological father, is the Moonlight Strangler, yet Karina Southerland is the latest victim in what appears to be a Moonlight Strangler attack. She's got the trademark slash on her cheek to prove it. And Karina is convinced Cord's father is innocent. Cord, though, is certain this is just another copycat killer. Still, Cord takes Karina into protective custody at his ranch hoping to keep her safe before the strangler attacks again. Only problem is their attraction is clouding their minds and cloudy thinking could get them both killed.

What a great story driven by the threat of danger and the promise of romance. Ms. Fossen reveals the twisting plot slowly with the stakes high. She tantalizes with hints of hope and a happy ending in doubt. In other words, she had me on the edge of my seat as this resourceful, fearless, lifelike couple fought for survival. The love story builds at the same time Cord and Karina confront escalating danger until finally it reaches a crescendo (and oh, what a crescendo!) that leaves the mystery solved and allowed me to finally breathe a sigh of relief.

My only regret in this book is that I discovered the series at the end. More than adequate background explanation is given and I at no time felt lost. I just felt aggravated that I had missed out on the story behind many of the secondary characters. "Laying Down the Law" is the sixth and final instalment of Delores Fossen's Appaloosa Pass Ranch series. The only book of the series not focusing on the Crockett family, the book instead centres around Addie Crocket's biological brother, Cord Granger. Having just recently been kidnapped and attacked by the man presumed to be the Moonlight Strangler, DEA agent Cord Granger is recuperating at the Crockett's ranch when he meets Karina Southerland, the woman convinced that Willie Lee Samuels is not actually the Moonlight Strangler. When Karina is attacked, Cord will have to protect her while they determine if her attacker really was the Moonlight Strangler or one of their various suspects.

While there were many similarities to the previous romantic suspense books in this series, the most interesting difference to me was the relationship between Cord and Karina. Despite having opposite feelings on Willie Lee's guilt, the two didn't have any long-standing feud preventing them from being together. I actually ended up liking their relationship more than the ones in the previous books as the author didn't follow such a predictable pattern.

Unfortunately, another pattern that the author broke in this book was the lack of previous characters in this book. Jericho and Addie are involved enough with a few appearances from Jax, but Levi, Chase, and the respective fiancees/wives were not included. One of the things that I'd liked most about the fifth book is how

active all the previous characters were. For the final book, it would have been interesting to get some closure.

Overall, the reveal of the Moonlight Strangler was well done and finished off the most important overall storyline in the series. Having powered through the series in a week, I was a bit disappointed with this ending, but would still recommend the whole series to any fans of romance/suspense.

The main problem was that the romance suffered from so much time being spent on building the mystery and the various players. There seemed to be little explanation for Cord and Karina falling in love. There was attraction, they shared a few kisses (some at odd moments), had sex, and that was the romance. As soon as the killer is caught, they exchange I love you's and plan to date for a month before getting engaged. Too little time was spent exploring the emotions, so I didn't feel the connection between the H and h.

As for the suspense plot, it felt contrived at times and I figured out the killer pretty early on. Not by name, but it wasn't hard to see there was only one explanation. Too many conveniences and too little romance made for a pretty average read.
