I don't think there is a story from Cynthia that I didn't enjoy from cover to cover. This is another one, albeit too short! I'm not sure how she is able to write some of the scenes with such reality and detail. Most of us take too much of our lives for granted, never knowing what it would be like to be limited in our abilities and senses. She's captured all that with the two main characters, Fiona Samuels and Chase Adams who both have experienced some personal tragedies that left them with long lasting scars, some superficial and some internal.

No longer an active duty soldier, Chase has returned from his time in the military with strong loyalties for those who survived with him and some reservations about anyone around him. He's found solace in audio books and even creates his own podcast, both of which don't require him to interact with many people and he likes it just like that. And then his buddy's wife asks him to audio produce with an author friend of hers. He has a soft spot for her and agrees, two weeks in and out so he can handle that.

Fiona Samuels has limited vision after being in a car accident as a child that killed her father. But since she lives in her childhood home, she's been able to learn how to live on her own there with only some limited help. Doing audio book narrating has given her a purpose and keeps her mind full of dreams.

These two tiptoe around each other at first and when Chase finds out that Fiona isn't the shrinking violet he expected, he lets his guard down ever so slightly. Fun read with some seriousness thrown in. Always the HEA and a heartfelt story that gives you hope for the human race!

As a retired Army Ranger he takes a job utilizing his computer skills and through his boss's wife gets the opportunity of a lifetime. As a favor, he is asked to help out a friend of theirs, the sultry voice that helped him survive rehab, Fiona Samuels. He is told it is a simple job, helping her record her new project, no danger involved; just using his audio and computer skills to fill in for Fiona's producer who unexpectedly retires leaving her in a tight spot. Aside from putting a face to the voice of his dreams, he has no idea what he signed on for or how much it could end up costing him.

Twenty years ago, Fiona was involved in an accident that killed her family and left her legally blind. Through struggles and hardships she has built a successful business as an audiobook voice actress. She works out of her home, she has her own studio and has kind of shut herself off from the world. Even though she is categorized as legally blind she can still see highlights of some shapes and images and she has an assistant who helps her with her day to day and a producer to help with her recordings before he unexpectedly retires leaving her in need of assistance. Aside from needing help with her recordings, strange things have started happening around her home. Not sure what to make of it, she mostly tries to put them out of her mind until things occur that cannot be ignored. She never had a clue she was in danger, let alone in her own home. Can she and Chase solve the puzzle before it is too late?

I really enjoyed the characters and watching them grow together as a couple. They both have their insecurities and reservations but they talk openly and share their struggles and feelings and it makes them stronger and more connected in the end. I also enjoyed the storyline and the plot of this book. It drew me in from the beginning and kept me wondering and guessing what was going to happen and who the bad guy was.
