Despite this, she also is preparing to bring her niece home from the hospital and is frightened at being inadequate to meet her niece's needs.

This is a funny mystery as we follow Maggie's attempts to save the day as she finds herself surrounded by her murder mentor, crime boss, crazy family members, and talking animals. Despite this, at times it is poignant as we see Maggie at her most vulnerable with her inner fears of inadequacy.
