This is a nearly perfect introduction to presidential history for toddlers and preschoolers. It recounts a bit of the history of ten of our most popular presidents, complete with rhyme and wonderful, bright illustrations. My only complaint is a small one. The left-hand pages follow the rhyme scheme, the right hand pages have an additional factual tidbit about the president, but in prose form, which felt disjointed to me. I wish the rhyming would have been consistent throughout all of the text.

{My Thoughts} – This is a wonderfully written and illustrated book about some of the more popular United States Presidents. I enjoyed how it was written in a poem like form and had extra information telling about each president. Children in pre-school and kindergarten aren't always aware of politics. They don't usually know who the president is or how important the past presidents were in helping to shape our country.
