Hidden Star - 2/5 - This whole trilogy was easily forgotten for me. I know I read it - heck I still have the books, so I had to skim through to remember most of it. I don't like amnesia stories and this is one. The heroine is TSTL for certain. Why would you mail - that's right, snail mail, priceless diamonds that people are trying to kill you for to your friends? First of all, the insurance on that package must have cost a fortune. Second, congratulations, you've just gotten your friends killed. Some friend she is. Cade is a great hero, but he's rather undeveloped. The focus in this story is in establishing the trilogy and Bailey's amnesia. I didn't hate it, but I've read better.

Captive Star - 3/5 - Jack and M.J's story was much more enjoyable than the first in the series. The suspense was better for one, as Jack, a bounty hunter realizes that M.J is not really a criminal and that people are trying to kill her for the diamond her stupid friend sent her and they spend their time dodging the bad guys, hiding out in a cabin, etc. The romance is also pretty great. And of course, the characters were much more likeable. Jack is a wonderful hero. MJ is overly stubborn and irritating at times, but it doesn't get in the way of my enjoyment. I must admit though, that in the long run, this was a pretty forgettable book. It doesn't stand out, but it is entertaining.

Secret Star - 2/5 - Tied with the first story for my least favorite of the trilogy. Grace isn't TSTL at least, but she's almost worse. She's cool, calm, collected and not afraid to use her body and her looks to get what she wants - but she has a vulnerable side of course. This is my least favorite character type that Nora Roberts writes. I like a strong, confident heroine, but I don't like it when they're manipulative, calculating and willing to use sex as a means to accomplish something. And Grace comes a little too close to this for my tastes. She has her good parts and what not, but I just couldn't identify with her nor really sympathize with her. Buchanan, the hero isn't bad, but I can't understand him. Why do heroes fall in love with heroines they don't

respect? Sure the respect comes eventually - but he finds himself falling in love with a woman that he barely knows and who he's been thinking the worst of all this time. The suspense in this book is definitely the best part. It wraps up nicely (even though the whole premise of mailing priceless diamonds was a bit ridiculous) and there's plenty of suspense here. I just didn't like the characters or the romance that much.

In the second book, Jack the bounty hunter gets a job to bring in MJ O'Leary.
