This was quite an interesting mix of paranormal lore and it was quite easy to see where this author was coming from.

*Nephilims have been part of biblical lore for millenia and some are quite curious about these characters. Some say they are giants and some go so far to point out the discovery of giant skeletons.

**Vampires have been part of man's folklore for countless millenia no matter what country or culture it may be. This is the same thing with werewolves.

The difference this book has compared to all the other paranormals I have read so far is that she managed to combine these lores and added a little bit of oomph to it.

Take for example Samuel's lack of stupidity and misdirected bravery or whatever else stupid reaction. Countless times I have been frustrated to read that the main characters, usually the "twink," acts just like the misdirected ideal of a twink: stupid, irresponsible, angsty, whining, etc.

Samuel is none of these. Instead his head is placed squarely on top of where it should be. He is logical, he is practical, and best of all: intelligent without being geeky.

Jackson is a wolf shifter and he has been with his vampire lover, Alek, for fifty years, both men know that one day Jackson will find his mate, but they are enjoying their relationship to the fullest until that time. Sam has always had the feeling that he is different, he never knew who his parents were and has grown up in foster care, when he meets Jackson and Alek he begins to discover just how different he really is. Alek is prepared for the worst when Jackson discovers his mate, Sam, but Sam isn't a normal human and Alek finds that maybe fate has blessed him as well as Jackson.

This is a great new paranormal series that loves to surprise. Sam has always known that he is different, he knows things about people that he shouldn't and can sense how a person feels, but he keeps it hidden. Sam is close to only a few people, his foster mother Rita, his foster brother Kieran and his cat Al, so when Sam meets Jackson and Alek he isn't sure why he is so drawn to them. Jackson and Alek have had fifty years together, but that doesn't stop Alek from great sadness when Sam enters their lives and Jackson might be overjoyed at finding his mate but he doesn't really want to lose the vampire he loves. All three together must work through what they could have together and Alek also might just have answers to Sam's unasked questions, Sam also comes to the rescue of a pack member which leads to a huge surprise.

I really enjoyed this story with its compassionate characters, intriguing storyline and exciting discoveries. Sam's parents are a mystery and we slowly discover the truth of who they were, we discover that Jackson's pack is more like a family and that Alek is well loved by all.
