One of the things I love about manga is that, because of its serialized nature and the uncertainty of initial success, every story that makes it past the first few volumes has more to offer than it first let on. *Yona's* Green Dragon arc - which starts in Volumes 5 and 6 - is my favorite plotline so far; now that the story is firmly established, characterization and plot are getting more complicated and Yona, in particular, is having her assumptions and motivations challenged. The whole 'heir to the kingdom must reclaim the throne' schtick is kind of tired and, well, regressive in this day and age... but Yona, increasingly, is seeking not just to restore the Kohka of her father but to improve upon it. Her royal lineage doesn't make her entitled to the throne, but instead gives her a sense of obligation to the people, which is a *much* more palatable narrative route.
