It's still as fascinating as the first book but is much darker and explored themes that I'm not too fond of. I suppose if readers can handle said themes then this will be a winner for them.

I was always curious on where the story will take us since the first book ended on a HFN and could've easily been a 'one and done' deal. Well, 'Blai2e' picks up right where 'Blaire' left off with Blaire being brought to the hospital for her injuries with Charlie by her side. Just when she thought she can finally have her happily ever after with Charlie, she is abducted, sold at an auction and to makes matters worse, they used heroin to control her during her captivity. While her time there didn't last long, she still has to deal with the withdrawals on top of her ongoing recovery from her brainwashing. Someone like her who's been conditioned for more than a decade to serve a master blindly just can't turn a switch off. She has to slowly learn how to think for herself and navigate the world on her own. Charlie's been her rock but he is hiding some very bad demons as well. In this book, we learn a whole lot more about the enigmatic Charlie Decena. We know that he's a ruthless crime lord but he's always been very patient and a sweetheart to Blaire. He continues to be like that here but Blaire will put his patience to the test at every turn and we are finally introduced to the much, much darker side of him. How will Blaire react once she sees this side of him and it completely shatters the 'knight in shining armor' image she has of him? Is her love for him strong enough for her to stick around? What if she has to choose him over something she considers to be too precious? Like her freedom or her brother? For his part, does Charlie love Blaire enough to hang on to her and all her baggage? Can someone like Blaire even live a normal life?

All of these things were interesting enough and kept me entertained but I miss the strong kickass Blaire that we had in the first book. There have been moments of that here but it's usually combined with a lot of 'too stupid to live' decisions on her part. While her conditioning made her vulnerable, she's always been a smart girl so seeing her do some really dumb stuff is quite frustrating. I'm a mixed bag on Charlie. I loved him for the most part and he really deserves a medal for putting up with Blaire and all her crap but... he does something towards the end that's one of my deal breakers. In a way, I get it and I can totally imagine anyone in his situation snapping like that but still...
