This book contains 3 previously released novels: Books 4, 5, and another. You will meet Rose, owner of the Rose Chalet, if you haven't read the boxed set of Four Weddings and a Fiasco (Books 1-3) or Say I Do (Books 1-3). NOTE this was not a typo, apparently both are available in some version, including single stories.

In The Wedding Dress, Gareth serves legal papers to Anne on behalf of Jasmine Turner. Who is Jasmine? Anne doesn't know her. Anne sneaks the papers back into Gareth's pocket.

In The Wedding Kiss, Rose is getting married to Donovan and having a hard time relaxing at her bridal shower. Donovan's mother is very rich, so perfect, and so condescending.

Sparks Fly is not strictly a Rose Chalet book although characters from the other books do make an appearance here. Angelina is hired by the ex-wife to feng shui Will's house. Will is not happy about it. Will decides to take a call and leaves Angelina standing outside with a door that the wind shuts.
