2. It refutes an argument that New Atheists and Neo Darwinians don't even make, disproving a model they don't even propose. Some areas were helpful, however, like the sections regarding the origin of life.

Overall, this work is indeed helpful, a classic in young-Earth creationism apologetics, but it's obviously obsolete in terms of scientific data in many places. On the positive side, Morris actually does make a large number of good arguments for his position. On the negative side, his arguments against other positions were really very poor and normally quite insulting. He seems to have virtually no idea what those he argues against actually believe.
