One issue is the redundancy, for example on page 10-11, clearly has the same paragraph written twice. Rebecca Graf mainly points out that 'many reviewers write negative reviews than positive one (page 102).' and she points out that there should be balance: both good and bad points about the novel/book. Furthermore, Rebecca has stated that paid reviewers tend to write positive reviews and/or give five stars; I would like to know what reviewers are these since I have done both complimentary and compensated reviews--always been honest and fair scoring based on my opinions or liking(s). This could be speculation or generalizing.

I agree with note taking, which I do since I've been in college and still follow thereafter which is very helpful when writing reviews, criticism, and/or scholarly reviews.
