The Good:

* The book has a Terry Pratchett vibe: the main character constantly tumbles from one situation in the next, and Big-Brother Computer Control is similar to Pratchett's *Death* by more characteristics than just the

uppercase font.

- * The place where the story is set, the bunker on venus, is very original and I can see why Wasserman wanted to revisit it.

- * At times the book is very funny, the Scammercial especially is a highlight.

The Bad:

- * Characters attitudes are not very consistent, and have dramatic attitude swings toward the main character. The main character self, Barney, is more upset about a non removable beeping spiked collar than he is about losing his genitals.

- * Some of the major plot devices' consequences are not being fully carried through. The kris master field especially, only does it's thing when it's convenient to the story.

- * At some times, the change of scenery can feel too quick, hurting the feel of continuity.

The Ugly:

- * Mr Wasserman sure loves his thesaurus! Every repetition of nouns and pronouns is avoided even if the alternatives are only semi-applicable.
