And let me just say that cozy romance is not my forte. So I was pretty disappointed.

The first story (Let it Snow by Debbie Macomber) was a pretty simple, enjoyable, quick holiday read. Cute characters, cute plot - exactly the type of warm and romantic holiday read I was looking for, but there was nothing life-shattering or laugh-out-loud about this one. No fireworks.

I made it about two chapters into the second story by Sherryl Woods before giving up. Even Barbara Kingsolver or a similarly talented writer couldn't have saved this plot: a harried mom of two, running a 104-degree fever, takes her son to the mall to see Santa on Christmas Eve, and loses him in the voracious shopping horde and only the temporary Santa - a cop with a heart of gold - can help. On every single count - count me out. I go out of my way to actively avoid any and all of these plot elements. 0 stars.

While the first and last stories are lovely and give you a warm tingly feeling about the magic of the season, the middle story really lets the side down.

A young, single mum in a new town takes her children to see Santa at the mall on Christmas Eve, determined to keep at least one Christmas tradition alive after her divorce. But when her young son runs off, seemingly too excited to wait in line, she starts to panic. In steps local cop, also playing the begrudging, if very handsome Santa that day.

Now, trying not to spoil this story; and as a mum myself, I found it very hard to give credence to the idea that any parent would allow themselves to eye up a potential date while in the panicked state of having lost their child. Secondly I also question the type of present the child tries to buy for his mum - quite unbelievable. This middle story is the longest in the book - but for me it went on too long, with a very unrealistic vibe.

The other two stories are cute and would be great for a short read with a hot drink when looking for a break from festive chaos.
