Kim Dare packs a lot into a short space. She not only managed to create two 3-dimensional characters but she also took on a fairly tricky subject: BDSM. I know this is one of her earliest works and somehow I never got around to reading it.

I tend not to read many shorter stories because they often leave me wanting more layers and depth. But Kim Dare provided plenty, and a satisfying conclusion for Alistair and Sheridan. I really liked the way these two characters worked as a couple, each one denying something of their personality because they thought the other wanted it that way. It's a fairly common plot, but it didn't feel cliched or worn in this little gem.

I also felt Kim presented the concepts and challenges underlying BDSM in a love relationship very well. Alistair feels he can't love Sheridan and dominate him at the same time, while Sheridan doesn't think anything Alistair could ask of him would degrade him. It felt very realistic for the characters to be dealing with these issues.

Why only 4 stars? I would like to have seen more sex. What there was was quite hot and nicely done, and fit perfectly with the characters and scene. It made sense for the story not to have more, so it works as is.

A few niggles with some head-hopping and use of epithets, but in general, a well-written and thoughtful short novella. It's not my first Kim Dare book, but if it were, I'd certainly want to read more after this one.
