This book was completely unexpected. The only thing I've ever read by Jessica Ingro before this was Take Me There, which is a compilation of taboo love/sex stories. So I knew she was good at writing sex, what I didn't expect was for this story-line to hook me from page one and leave me cussing and screaming at the cliffhanger. Yes, there is a cliffhanger. Take note of that, because no one told me when I read it. I had no idea until the end, and then it was too late to save myself.

Alyssa is a single mother whose husband is in jail and she can barely afford to put food on the table for her little girl, Sophie. She's at the end of her rope and decides to shove down her pride and do whatever it takes to take care of her daughter. She gets a job at an upscale strip club that also happens to be a place men can pay to have sex.

Xavier owns the place and finds himself wanting to help her out the first time he meets her. The problem is, he can't stand the thought of anyone having sex with her so he does his best to make sure that doesn't happen.
