There are so many reasons why I love this series. Perhaps first on the list would be that Golden is a Hoosier author who resides in the same area of Indiana that I do. Second would be cats. I love stories that involve cats who actually do something, and certainly the cats in this series, especially Scout and Abbra, manage to be an integral part of the stories in this series without doing much of anything that isn't cat-like. Third would be that the stories are plotted and paced well, using believable dialogue, situations that are relatable, and characters that are consistently well-drawn.

In this series, Katz and her best friend, Colleen, and Colleen's mother, Mum, are going on a Girls' Retreat,

spending a long weekend in a cabin on the edge of Lake Michigan adjacent to the Indiana Dunes. Colleen's wedding looms large, and the stress of the wedding planning, which is not going well, is getting to everyone. It is out of season, so the cabins are not fully rented, although the ladies will have neighbors, most remarkably, a young woman named Kate, in the cabin next door. The ladies' S.O.s, Jake and Daryl, will come up on Sunday to finish out the weekend. The area of the beach along which the cabins set is reputed to be haunted, which appeals to Colleen's ghost-hunter persona. When Scout and Abra go into their never-fails death dance, and the ladies catch a glimpse of the beach's ghost, things get tricky. Whose death does the appearance of the ghost, and the Siamese's dance portend?

The only thing about this series that could make me happier would be if Golden published more than once a year! If you are a mystery lover who prefers novels with a definite mystery, a few twists and turns, a red herring or two, lots of relatable action, great characters, and no cliffhanger endings, this series is made for you.
