Book 4, **Falling for Love** starts with Grant waking after his sister's wedding with a bad hangover and in bed with Stephanie, an employee of his parents. Stephanie has had some bad luck growing up, has no close friends, no family except a step father who is currently in prison for a crime he didn't commit. Stephanie knows Grant used her to try to make Abby jealous, but as they get to know each other better Grant starts to question if Abby is who he really wants or if it was just young love.
