We get to know the Niko's story and how he took Thomas's place when he went to work with Cobra - Thomas owes him for this, because he would have never met the 2 people in his life that he loves more than anything.

There are only a couple times when Thomas is able to get away and visit with Kitten and Garrett - Valentine's Day was one of them.. the day Garrett was ignoring Kitten because he had to work in the attic - although he was feeling guilty, he was still enjoying himself...

There is a lot of emotional up and downs in this book - lol when is there not!?! But it's nice to see the happy ménage after their Happily Ever After.
