Entrapment was beyond unbelievable and an affront to the reader's intelligence. It was obvious that Romig was playing the puppet master, manipulating her characters to the point this story moved from being suspenseful to becoming a caricature of good Southern gentility.

The premise of an arranged marriage between Charli and Bryce (as stipulated by Charli's grandfather's Will) to the point that Charli is kidnapped then held hostage, was flawed.

This reader imagined so many scenarios that could have effectively incapacitated Alton thereby rendering his control over Charli and her "Momma" (God, I hated that word) ineffectual. (view spoiler)

This book also depicted southern women as mere figureheads willing to debase themselves by allowing their men to physically, mentally and psychologically abuse them while maintaining a "men will be men" persona.

If I were a woman from the South, I'd be extremely offended by Entrapment.

Romig was ambitious in setting this story in five parts which perhaps is a strategy that worked well with her other books but, not so much with this. This entire book could have been tacked on to book 3 as no more than 1 or 2 chapters and we still wouldn't have missed any major developments.

Writing words on paper does not make a story. We need dialogue that's authentic; a plot sequence and pace that's authentic; character development that supports the plot and is, here's that word again, **AUTHENTIC!** As much as I've loved her other books, my advice to Ms. Romig is: Be authentic and more isn't always better.

Serials 1-3 were quite entertaining this however, was mere filler.

With only one book remaining in the series, this book paves the way for what is bound to be an explosive ending. Chelsea plays a more pivotal role in this installment as well. Her character really kept me engaged in the story. It was clear that she was suffering even more than Alex. Bryce also showed his true colors in this book. We've seen glimpses of his arrogant, ill-tempered behavior before, but now we're given the whole, ugly truth. He is a psychopath!

When he was in a scene, the hairs on the back of my neck stood on end. This guy is a violent predator that gets off on humiliation and domination. Rest assured that Bryce probably has a string of victims everywhere he's traveled.

Nox is slowly losing his mind from worry and from the responsibility of letting her go. But he will be back full force:

Alton treats Alex like a spoiled teenager girl and sends her to her room after he announces to her that she is getting married before Christmas.

Bryce is trying to convince Alex (not very successfully) that they are best friends and they need to get married to seal their love, while he tells sweet things to her like:

"Always the proper lady, except when you're spreading your legs for trash like Demetri..." Or "...you don't want to be responsible for what will happen when you disappoint me."

Chelsea is living her nightmare being Bryce's whore and being hated by her ex-best friend.

Suzanna supports Bryce, her son, and exchanges slaps with Alex while she is ecstatic to prepare the wedding of the century.

Everybody is calling Alton, "Alexandria's father" and not "Alexandria's STEP-father", while Alex is trying really hard to remind everybody that she is the only Montague present in the Montague Manor.

Adelaide does not know where she is. I believe being held in a mental institute without being crazy; slowly losing your mind is the scenario for some of the best horror books and movies. Nevertheless, Adelaide still waits for Oren to come with his shiny armor and save her.

Oren has a lot of explanation to do – especially to his son. It is hard to explain how sometimes even the most successful marriages can fall apart, that the love between the ex-partners will never end and that it is possible

to love twice in your life.

I am absolutely sure that everything will be okay in the end. But I was still feeling such anxiety when I was reading this book and I was gasping constantly with some of the most obscene dialogues.

How can the villains use this kind of language and treatment? Are they playing mind games? They are definitely using psychological abuse and emotional abuse to convince Alex.
