It took me a while to warm up to the protagonists – mostly since in direct contrast to the previous volume I did not really feel a connection between those two. (Then again, their opposite natures are part of the theme here.)

And even once I got to know them better, the story meandered along. That is not to say it went on tangents or was boring. It simply was a relationship story with developments over time and both parties figuring out their path together.

Initially I was with Mikey on the mate issue and wished Collin would stop asking. Having ambiguity (choice) had been what I'd been hoping for from this series from the beginning, to be honest.

However, Mikey's plans and rules began to turn silly after a little while. (view spoiler)

And yet, this is part of what this story is about. Mikey – huge, buff, confident guy that he seems – is at the core deeply uncertain. So yes, an actual relationship story. I don't have a better way to put it.
