If you enjoy Christian-themed mystic type teen fiction, or fiction based in early century settings (without all of the thees and thous) you will enjoy this book. It is the first in a series by a newly published author. She does a good job of giving adequate descriptions without being too embellished. The book left off without too many lingering questions but anticipating the next book in the series (yet to be published as of 9/12). There is romance throughout the book, but it is not the main focus and is appropriate for all ages. She does an excellent job at developing her characters and the mysteries surrounding them as well as the places mentioned in the book. The Christian theme is apparent, but not "Bible-y", meaning someone who is not a Christian should enjoy the book as well without needing any Biblical knowledge. However, a Christian will easily pick up the conflict between Eloah's people and those who choose to follow Lord Sife. I personally know the author, so I understand and appreciate the spattering of scientific details throughout the book, but again, a non-science person will appreciate the details without needing a strong science knowledge. It is an easy and fairly quick read for any reader. There are a few challenging words, but very few and most of them are due to the period-style setting. I thoroughly enjoyed the book and would recommend it to anyone.
