While being well written and interesting, I must state a big objection to the ending, or lack of one. It has the sharpest cliffhanger I've ever read. There was no closure, no answers, no ending what-so-ever. You might wish to buy the next book before you read this one. I was very disappointed with the complete lack of an ending.
