In Highland Surrender Dawn Halliday masterfully writes a novel with sweeping passion and intrigue as the main characters are torn between love and duty. This wild Scottish romance is filled with unconventional characters that were easy to care for. Highland Surrender is the 2nd book in Dawn Halliday's long awaited

conclusion to her Highland series. In this book we are treated to Cam's story.

Cam has been a womanizer for most of his life; his good looks have made it easy to overlook his intelligence and decency. As the Earl of Camdonn he is regarded as a wastrel and although he is Scottish his English ties have made him suspicious to his own people.

In Dawn Halliday's earlier book *Highland Obsession*, Cam found and lost the love of Sorcha to his best friend Alan. Brokenhearted but determined to bring back honor and stability to his land Cam is determined to marry the very English, Lady Elizabeth. A bride who is perfect but one he knows he could never love. But his plans are waylaid when he and his bride-to-be are attacked on their way to his home. Although he saves Lady Elizabeth, Cam finds himself severely wounded but somehow finds his way to the sheltering and sultry arms of the healer, Ceana MacNab. A woman as elusive and tempestuous as the Scottish Highlands. Captivated by her beauty and spirit Cam finds himself torn between duty and love. But even if he could free himself the independent Ceana makes it known to him that she will never marry.

This story actually includes 2 love stories. While I enjoyed the steamy romance between Ceana and Cam, I actually found myself drawn toward the secondary love story. In the secondary story the 2 lovers are quite tortured and discovering the mystery behind their painful past really kept me spellbound.

Dawn Halliday's books are not the typical romance. She introduces characters that are not perfect but ones that the reader can easily connect with. The villain is truly evil and I rooted for the heroes and heroines. (Who wouldn't love a story that is filled with wounded characters finding each other and finally healing through love?) Dawn Halliday's stories may be a bit too sensual for some readers but I felt the erotic were essential in showing the passion the characters have for each other even from the very beginning.

I highly recommend this book to readers especially if you have weakness for brawny highlanders! This is yet another winner from an accomplished writer that I always look forward to reading!

The Earl of Camdonn has selected a wife amongst London's offerings based on the requisite that he not feel the slightest bit of passion for his countess to be. While Lady Elizabeth is perfection personified, Cam is relieved to feel nothing for his beautiful bride and signs the betrothal contract with nary a pause. However, life can never be easy for Cam and Fate soon makes its presence known when Cam is shot and cared for by the Highland healer, Ceana MacNab.

Descendant from a line of female healers, Ceana is cursed to never marry. Stealing her emotions, Ceana has sought comfort when she's desired warm arms to hold her and turned away when her heart became too engaged but when the Earl of Camdonn's life's blood is spilling before her, Ceana can't contain the possessive emotions that flood her heart. With news that Cam has brought home his English bride, Ceana knows that she must stay as far from the earl as possible but distrust for the resident doctor at Camdonn Castle has Ceana following Cam home.

Cam, doing his best to learn from his past obsessive behavior with women, tries with all his might to

maintain distance from Ceana for his future's sake. He needs the connections that Lady Elizabeth brings and he's sworn to honor his vows. But Cam's not married yet and while he knows that's no excuse he still can't help his raging desire where Ceana is concerned.

For Elizabeth, Cam represents her long sought for freedom. Since she was a little girl, Elizabeth has lived in utter terror of her Uncle Walter, the Duke of Irvington. Unable to curb her headstrong behavior, Uncle Walter devised a cruel way of punishing Elizabeth that leaves her physically unharmed but psychologically tortured. She knows that Cam feels nothing for her but she also recognizes his honorable heart and hopes that one day they might find affection. Unfortunately dire circumstances forces Elizabeth into the company of Robert MacLean, the earl's stable master. Recognizing a deep-seeded control within Robert, Elizabeth finds him utterly compelling but mostly she finds sanctuary in his presence. Despite the fact that this point in her life is the most crucial to her survival, Elizabeth can't help her growing passion for Rob. Even Uncle Walter's punishments can't instill enough fear within her to distill her yearnings.

Since reaching manhood, Robert has been longing for a woman that needs him not only for her safety and well being but for her physical release as well. His passions run dark and he's yet found the opportunity to unleash his inner beast that demands complete submission until he meets the beautiful Lady Elizabeth. No woman has been more beyond Robert's reach but he can't help his body's recognition of its mate. Within her seemingly fragile form, Robert discerns equally dark passions within Elizabeth as well as the need to relinquish control. Her entire facade is rigidly schooled to present an image that couldn't be more opposite of the hellion within. Robert wants nothing but to set her free within his domain and even though he risks his very life to pursue the earl's betrothed, Robert can't stop the raging possession that tears at his soul.

So here's the conundrum: Cam needs Lady Elizabeth's connections but Ceana's highly respected reputation with his Highland tenants could also help him in his task of winning over his people. Ceana can't and won't marry because of a deadly curse and the last thing she wants is for Cam to die because of her. She loves him, yes, but she also loves him enough to let him go. Elizabeth recognizes Cam as her freedom from her terrifying uncle but there's also a form of freedom with Robert. She loves Robert where she can barely speak to Cam. Robert can't stand the thought of the earl possessing Elizabeth and while every fiber within him demands that he make her his, Robert also knows that he could never provide Elizabeth with the life she's accustomed to. And Fate is determined to mess with them all.

HIGHLAND SURRENDER is a tale of two separate couples whose fate is complexly interwoven resulting in each move made by one affecting the whole and forcing their Happily Ever After's to be precarious and rife with tension.

I really enjoyed the dual interwoven romances and the feel of having two romances in one. Both stories were intensely compelling and captivated my interest from beginning to end. There's great anxiety over whether or not an HEA for each couple is possible and as you barrel towards the end, your knuckles may turn a bit white from your death grip on the book.

After finishing **HIGHLAND SURRENDER**, I'm hard pressed to pick a favorite couple amongst the two. Cam's and Ceana's story is radically different from Robert's and Elizabeth's despite their close connection. For me, my love for each was crucial to the success of the novel and I thought that Dawn Halliday did a superb job with this very complex but refreshing plot.

Readers wanting a two for the price of one, look no further than **HIGHLAND SURRENDER**. Twice the steamy sex plus twice the intense romance equals one scintillating read that shouldn't be missed. Elizabeth is rescued by Robert MacLean, a groom from the castle who has tried to keep the peace among Cam's people while he's been away for months on end.

Ceana comes from a long line of healers who have lived with the curse of losing their beloveds, so she's sworn never to love or marry again. But taking care of Cam while he heals puts her to the test. Their attraction is immediate, passion flares between them. They both do an admirable job of staying away from each other, even despite stolen glances and sizzling kisses. That, of course, can only last so long.

Keeping his secret close to the vest has kept Robert on Camdonn lands for a number of years now, but once

Elizabeth comes to him in the stables, wants to be with the groom instead of the earl, he bears his soul but refuses to betray the only family he has left.

But all of these characters can only hold out so long against their passionate natures. Secrets are learned, those passions are let free, betrayals forgiven, and lives begin to be joyously lived. I really like how they don't let the wrong thing get in the way of their happiness; they look at everything as it is and as it could be, as it should be, and make the right decisions.
