Peter is very close to shifting which entails seeing his lover literally like a piece of meat to devour. Darwin finally secures another lesser-bred to help provide Peter with what he needs. Unlike Darwin, lesser-bred can regenerate body parts which have been eaten while in the middle of sex.
