Okay, let's check out the cover first. Yum! Now, the title. One thing I have noticed about the majority of the Mills & Boon books is that the titles are, well, awful. I sometimes wonder if the powers that be have some sort of competition going to see who can come up with the worst title. Half the time, it doesn't even have anything to do with the story. I'm really not loving the title for this book. Pulled under what?

Moving on. Oh, Harper and Levi. They both have trust issues, poor dears, and rightly so. They've both been betrayed by people they should have been able to trust, Harper more so, which means she finds it hard to trust Levi and the feelings she develops for him. It doesn't help that Levi lies and withholds information she needs to do her job, and of course, when it finally comes out, she arrests his ass as any good IRS agent would do... even though she's already in love with him.

Throw in some seriously shifty partners on his part, a somewhat strange one on hers, and it's a wonder they weren't both nervous wrecks by the end of it. I do think the way they sparred on the first day was a little unprofessional on her part, and the way he called her "Harp" here and there was annoying, but otherwise it was a good read and the sex scenes were hot \*g\*

While there was some witty dialogue and it had the potential to be interesting, I am 25% through the book and am seriously considering abandoning.

By the time I got to the end of Chapter Three I had already made 3 notes in the margin remarking "I am really not liking her..."

He started out OK, but the scene where he brings her up on stage while he is stripping crosses too many boundaries for me. At this point there is some inappropriate touching instigated by both him and her in front of an audience and it is clear if this actually happened she would ethically have to recuse herself from the case she is investigating. I am not prudish and I love the Blaze line of stories, but was struck by how icky this scene felt.

So by page 40 I am already biased against both main characters and strongly unimpressed by the basic modus operandi of either character in the plotting of sexual power games.

Seriously considering skimming for basic plot highlights and then toasting it from my e-library.

OK later that day, I went back and tried reading further. More red flags at end of strip club stage scene when she asks him to put her down and he continues dry humping her and she asks again to be let off the stage but

the act continues until she finally walks away. Left really bad taste in my mouth - sorry but is this not the current social issue currently being debated about consent?

I did finish the book and there were some well written parts where I came to like the characters more. Loved that she was the motorcycle maven and she has major tats that she had to hide under her IRS conservative suit - great spin for a heroine. There were also some very funny, witty lines including a keeper where she throws in a YODAism. Very funny.

But overall I just can't see myself re-reading the book. I feel it would have been much stronger without the scene with her on stage and I would actually have cared what happened to these people. Final rating: 1.5 Stars
