What we have here is a brand new mafia serial that follows a similar concept as Aleksandr Voinov's mafia series Dark Soul, by publishing one novella-sized chapter at a time. Yeah, I know what you're thinking. Not everyone's pleased with this particular marketing strategy; collecting a series this way will cost you an arm and a leg. Season 1 of Guns n' Boys consists of 8 episodes, each \$ 2,99. However, joining the mailing list of the authors will allow you to get them for \$ 0,99 each AND season 1 will be 200.000 words total.

So, are the mafiosi in Guns n' Boys worth it? Hmm..yes and no. Personally, I had to adjust my expectations when reading this first episode. The thing is, when I read a story about the Cosa Nostra, I want to feel the

stifling family ties. I want to be a part of the ruthless plotting during a meal of Pasta con le sarde. I want to be immersed in their way of life. Even though some of the mystique vaporizes when you realize that the younger generations of the Family are not above flaunting their wealth, beauty and selfies on Facebook and Instagram (hereby breaking the ‘code of silence’ and popping up on the radar of the public and the police). Oh irony! Will social media be the downfall of the centuries old mafia? Anyway, I digress!

Back to Guns n’ Boys: once I resigned myself to the fact that this is not about careful plotting and a subtle build up of tension between the MCs, I tried to enjoy this for the junkfood that it is. That doesn’t change the fact that this episode feels rushed. In 70 pages, MC Seth — who thinks he’s managed to escaped the clutches of his Sicilian family and lives a comfy life in New York — gets abducted by a rivaling crime syndicate and then swapped for a suitcase of money to be escorted back home by the Family’s ruthless killer Domenico. Following, the authors hurriedly take you on a tour through ‘blunt’ revelations and developments that I won’t get into due to spoilers, but that require you to suspend your disbelief.

To be honest, the story was too simple and obvious for me. Something that became especially aggravating where the instant lust between the MCs was concerned. From the moment Seth first laid eyes upon Domenico, there weren’t enough predators in the animal kingdom to describe the man’s handsomeness. Seth thought of him as ‘a handsome sleek panther’, a ‘wild beast’ that makes him ‘stop breathing. It was like being watched by a puma’. One with ‘a plate of incredible abs and thighs of a cheetah, with a side order of a gorgeous set of balls’. You get the idea?

When the POV switched to Domenico I hoped for less exaggerated admiration and more depth. After all, here came the brooding, sociopath killer from the blurb, right? Well, I can’t comment on Domenico’s mindfuck material factor, since he, too, was all about thinking with his dick and comparing Seth to a.. “bull with a juicy body: big, tall, and meaty, with broad shoulders and thighs that invited for a bite.” Despite the sex being hot (until the condom bullshit: either you use one or you don’t. Just don’t spoil a perfectly fine sex scene by crying ‘Uncle’ afterwards), I was stunned that the authors gave it all away so easily in a first episode!

**Great dark humor entwined with super delicious dirty sex and a handful of surreal situations.**

**Acerbi&Villani or the fable of the panther and the fawn.** Or was it a ferocious lion and a little lamb? Well, I'm not sure about how enunciate it, but what I know for certain is that **Dom is an animal**. A beautiful and dangerous one. Elegant in his appearance, he's strong, scary, kinda insensitive at first sight and a powerful magnet. To Seth and to me. Both. **He's a charismatic character and his weight is so heavy you can't avoid him**. If he is in your way, prepare yourself to get caught.

On the other hand we have **bratty and apparently mafia useless, Seth**. Is he really a sheep? at the beginning I asked myself that question countless times because I was sure he was a wolf perfectly disguised. But nope, I was wrong, he was that naive, he wasn't wearing a costume, his whinny skin was just that: simply clueless. And when I accepted that fact, I started my love story with his oblivious ass. Because **he was exactly what a cynic assassin with a dark soul needed to match him, to complete him, to give him some light**.

**The love story between -cocky full of himself- Domenico Acerbi and -unfocused and a bit lost mafia designed successor- Seth Villani is dark, twisted, erotic and funny.** It's just an introduction, just the beginning of what I think will be an epic love story. Here we have more sex than love story development. Two men attracted to each other. And what surprised me the most about me loving the hell out of this book is that I'm a very specific kind of MM reader. I get the most in slow burns or bittersweet YA books. Lovely but a bit angst stories with a lot of banter and just a few sex scenes (if any). And if you haven't realized yet, this story is far from all I've described. We certainly have a lot of banter (high quality) but also tons of sex and surprisingly, I welcomed every single naughty scene in it.

I have a huge dichotomy in my book tastes and that makes me the reader I am, and I'm so comfortable with it. I'm proud to love my sweet angst teenage stories and also proud of my need to feed my dark side every now and then. This book? Fed all my twisted desires like no other.

Although I have truly enjoyed most of the books that I have read by Merikan, K.A. and although this series “Guns n' Boys” was on my radar for some time now; I hesitated to start it.

The obvious reason is the incest. The two main characters, Seth Villani and Domenico Acerbi aka Dom, are half brothers. They have the same father. This is not what I normally prefer in my books. Or to be blunt here, I normal detest it when two close relatives have a romantic relationship (no matter how much Game of Thrones I have watched).

So I was very reluctant to start this book and this series. But I was curious, I wanted to expand my horizon, I would love to read an MM mafia romance etc etc etc. Anyway, I am glad that I read this book, because I truly liked it.

The fact that the two protagonists are half brothers is not a big deal in the book – other that the fact that Dom is jealous of Seth and maybe other than the fact that their bond will strengthen their relationship. Their father has never acknowledged Dom as his son. He actually shot him and almost killed him when he was 11 and he tried to stab Seth because he was jealous. After that Seth and Dom have grown up apart. Seth in United States (free as a bird) and Dom in Sicily, Italy (where nobody is allowed to be gay) and they only meet again when Seth is in trouble and he needs to go back to Italy, back to the Family.

Dom will need to be Seth's mentor and babysitter and they will start a secret affair.

In their relationship Dom will play the dominant, intimidating part (he is a professional killer after all) and Seth will be the crybaby who does not want to be associated with mafia but he cannot avoid it.

In Germany where they will end up in order to complete Seth's "mafia education", Dom will be constantly disappointed by Seth's progress. I have to say here that I have a feeling that the situation will turn in the next books and Seth will be more ruthless than Dom (Let's point out here that he is the Mafia Don's son i.e. Don Dino Valliani's son . He can be cruel!).

Anyway, the book has a lot of violence, sex, but also a subtle, clever sense of humor that it is difficult to find in this kind of books.

So in truth I must admit I can't honestly explain why I kept reading this with reasonable arguments. Half of the time I was pissed off. I guess it's the other half that prevented me from quitting entirely. I love the chemistry here and that's considering I hate Domenico's guts with all my heart.

Domenico is lots of things in the dictionary and rarely good: insufferable, despicable, arrogant, odious, impertinent, cruel, selfish, big-headed, abusive. A bully, a rapist and a bastard (and not only in the (view spoiler), it seems). He feels superior to Seth, (view spoiler) but of course Seth has to do it with no discussion (because BTW he is a prick). He makes fun of Seth but Seth can't do it with Dom. He is above all joke, it seems. He is untouchable and I despise that.

Domenico “Dom” Acerbi is an assassin and from a young age sworn by oath into the Villani family. Having grown up around the Villani brothers, Domenico knows their strengths and weaknesses, and while he is a worthy ally, Dom has always known his place in the hierarchy. As most in the family are shocked by the Don’s decision to place Seth at the helm, Domenico is also surprised to be tasked with training such a softie like Seth. Knowing what’s at stake, Dom proceeds despite his undeniable attraction to a beefy man like Seth.

Sent to Berlin for training and to uncover needed information vital to the family, Seth is forced to shadow Domenico at every moment for his own protection. My love for DOM and Seth got even bigger, if this is even possible. Can't explain in words how amazing it was to revisit these wonderful MC as they were at the beginning of their adventures.

Initial review:

I've read some pretty great books lately, especially the Sex & Meyhem series by K.A. Merikan, BUT **Guns n' Boys** is in a league of its own.

**Seth Villani** is the youngest son of a DON - the boss of an Italian mafia family. He wanted to escape their brutal and bloody world and moved to the States where he lived with his boyfriend.

He thought his life was safe, but he was abducted and then his life changed in a blink of an eye.

Brutally honest, sexy and with a dirty mind, he doesn't give two f he shouldn't push Seth's boundaries. He does what he wants, ignoring all rules, but while training Seth to become the next Don, he falls for him, hard and unexpectedly.

I don't want to give too much away, so I will ask you to *carefully read the book's presentation.*

If you are into dark MM stories, with mafia, shootings, blood and a lot of action, then this is **the best choice**. BUT be aware that you're diving in a story with some *dubious consent and coercion*, and also something that can be disturbing for some people. I'm not going to reveal it, you should discover on your own. I haven't got a problem with it, but it might make you uncomfortable while reading the story.

**... it did not sweep me off my feet like I thought it would.**

I had a bit of a hard time to rate this book because I have some mixed feelings about it. Altogether I liked it and I really enjoyed some parts of it, but others... not so much.

On the positive side there would definitely be Dom. Honestly? What's not to love about a gorgeous, dangerous, somewhat unpredictable guy with a bit of an attitude, who sometimes shows his vulnerable side, especially when it comes to the rejection by his own father?

Yes, I know , basically, he is a killer, but still...

Seth, on the other hand, has attitude in spades... Unfortunately, not the one that struck a chord with me. This guy was most of the time annoying as hell. Overall too shallow, with the inclination to put too much emphasis on outward appearances. Well, that was something that bothered me a bit in general about this book. Sometimes I even got the impression I was reading a fashion magazine rather than a mafia story, but that only as a side note, so back to Seth. Kidnapped as the youngest son of a Sicilian Mafia don by the Chinese Triad, being tortured and held captive for several weeks...

... and the first thing that came to his mind when he is being rescued is that the suit his kidnappers gave him was somewhat ill-fitting compared to the one of his savior (Dom). Seriously? Oh, come on. (Maybe you can imagine my eye-roll...) Most of the time his behavior was that of a spoiled brat, not to say a drama queen, and everytime he insisted that Dom should not treat him like a baby, I wanted to snap at him "Oh, yeah? Then don't behave like one!"

Thank God, it got better towards the end, at least a bit, as well as the development of the relationship between Dom and Seth. At first I didn't really feel the connection between these two, especially because Dom had no problem with sharing Seth. Of course, it all based on sex at the beginning and since this is just the first book in a series I guess it will deepen, so I don't want to judge it too hard.

Well, said sex can only be described with one word:

Admittedly, at the beginning it was somewhat dub-con \*cough\*, but since Seth could enjoy it, I could do the same. ;-) Surprisingly, the fact that Dom and Seth are (view spoiler) didn't bother me overly much, either.
