However I hate to spend money and be totally frustrated and disappointed with my purchase and I wanted people to be aware of this before they get this. This book has many, wide ranging patterns for the novice to learn to use a sewing machine. The book and patterns are aimed at a total novice with clear instructions, however not a single photograph or sketch to **SHOW** you what you are aiming for and how close to the intended item you got!

I read the Kindle version and it was the most annoying book I have ever read. Every page I 'turned' caused a pop up that asked me to subscribe. To get the pictures for the projects, I had to subscribe and then find the right link for the gallery. This is a very basic book, and a good place to start if you have never sewn in your life, or it has been a few decades (think Home Ec in 8th grade) However the pop ups were so distracting and frustrating, and having to look at the instructions (with NO PICS) and then flip over to a website to view what the finished project looked like was just too much of an annoyance.

I don't really know why I downloaded this, as I'm an experienced seamstress, but I think it was free and I love reading sewing books so I had a look. It is absolutely NOT what it purports to be. There is a section at the front with very basic information on names of stitches and bits of your machine, but nothing that you can't get better elsewhere. There's no information on techniques, and the rest of the book is 50 very basic projects which again you can get online from blogs and websites for free, and probably better because, at least in the Kindle version, there are no pictures to follow.

If you want to learn to sew then I'd start with free online resources, then invest in some decent books on pattern cutting and technique (a good starter is the Dorling Kindersley book on sewing, which I still sometimes refer to myself) as this book has nothing of any value in it and wasn't worth buying even when free! A huge disappointment.
