This is the best anthology I've ever read! ***Pucker Up**

Wow, another fantastic story in this anthology! This is an opposites attract story, with some twists, with the possibilities being endless for the continuation! Interesting plot that kept me guessing & wondering if the couple can get past their differences.

***Secret Demons**

Fantastic story! This story has lots of potential for an on going series. There is a big cliff-hanger ending but the kind that makes you want the next book in a bad way. ***Chameleon**
