Lisa Cardiff has done the impossible. I thought it didn't get much better than the first book in her Before You series, but she has proven me wrong here! "Redeeming You" is captivating and moving. It will have you on the edge of whatever you're sitting on as she gives you a hard look at what redemption means and the struggle it takes to get there.

A year after the fact, Cam is still reeling over the loss of Bre. His self-destructive ways have made him a ticking time bomb on the verge of exploding and taking his band, Chasing Ruin, down with him. When his bandmates and the music label decide they've had enough, they hire a chaperone to keep an eye on Cam as they finish out their tour. As sparks fly between him and his newly appointed babysitter, Taylor, will Cam take advantage of his second chance and turn his life around or will he finally go too far and lose everything?

I think I'm not alone when I say that the Cam from book one was a complete douchebag. The way he treated Bre was disgusting and I was quite happy to see him get everything he had coming. I honestly didn't believe him capable of change. Now I must bow to the talent that is Cardiff, because she has completely changed my opinion of this character. Cam is lost and lonely and feels completely unworthy of anything good. He sees the mistakes of his past and has spent the last year trying to drown out the regret beating him down. Sadly, all he has succeeded in doing is making himself feel even more like a loser and alienating the only people he really cares about. I loved watching him come to terms with how much he has screwed up. Cardiff did an amazing job of keeping him honest and real and never made his journey toward redemption easy. He struggled and triumphed and through that won my respect. I was totally invested in him and rooting for him to find his happy ending.

Taylor isn't all unicorns and happy thoughts. She's had a hard life and has allowed her past to strip her of all her self-worth. Her brother, Alec (Cam's bandmate), has done his best to protect her but even he can't repair the emotional damage that their childhood has left behind. I love that Cardiff made Taylor just as broken as Cam. She brought her own neurosis to the table and she screwed up just as much as Cam did. She wasn't perfect and he helped heal her as much as she did for him. They were on somewhat equal footing and the road to redemption is one they traveled together. They needed each other and while their chemistry was undeniable, it was their emotional connection that kept me tuned in page after page.

I love to read Cardiff's work. Her writing is seamless and flows effortlessly off the page. I'm sucked in

immediately and can't ever find a good place to put the book down. I love that she continues to fold her secondary characters in nicely and has already set up the next book in the series quite well. He and Aubrey have a deep connection and after all of Cam's lies and betrayals are revealed, Jax and Aubrey have their HEA. This leads us to this book where Cam is left devastated after losing his childhood sweetheart and having to watch her move on.

As I said, the jury is still out on Cam, I do not like his sense of arrogance and entitlement. I wanted to see if he would redeem himself in this book, and to be honest I don't feel like he did. Lisa Cardiff delivers a powerful read, she gives readers a taste of what drugs, alcohol, sex and Rock and Roll is really about. Cam is on a downward spiral, he can't get over losing Aubrey.

“She is marrying She’s marrying Jax. She loves him.”

“You’re right, she does and Jax loves her. More than you ever did.”

“You don’t know sh*t.”

“If you really loved her, you would have never touched another woman, not once. You only love the idea of her.”

Cam becomes reckless, a danger to himself, a problem for the record label and a problem for the band. Jax and the record label have no choice but to step in and try to save Cam and the Chasing Ruin after a sex and drug filled video goes viral. Cam is still in denial and does not think there is a problem, and does not NEED help. That is until the record label, gives an ultimatum.

“You don’t care about yourself and apparently, you don’t give a sh*t about the band. Did you even notice you were being taped?”

“Maybe, but I was kind of preoccupied at the moment if you didn’t notice.”

“The label is livid. The sex tape is one thing, but the drugs in the background are a game changer. The label wants you to submit to regular drug testing, or we have to hire a chaperone to follow you around..

“What do the guys want me to do?”

Enter Taylor Reed, she has just gotten out of an abusive relationship and has no home or money. Her brother Alec a drummer for Chasing Ruin offers her the job of Nanny to Cam. Tay needs to earn some money and create distance from her past, besides 30 days is nothing? Cam of course does not make things easy for Tay. Like I said he is arrogant and feels a sense of entitlement.

“He agreed.”

“So he’s fine with it?”

“Fine wouldn’t be the word I use, but he agreed and that’s all that matters.”

“You look fine now. But it looks as though you have a tendency to gain weight in your hips. You might want to limit your late night snack to a salad.”

“What’s your problem with me? I didn’t do anything to you? I didn’t create the job. There’s no reason to insult me.”

“I would’ve happily peed in a cup for the remainder of the tour, but no, you needed a job, so now I’m stuck with you as my sidekick for a month.”

For the next 30 days, Tay and Cam develop feelings for one another but knowing Cam is not over Bre and the fact that he does not do relationships, they agree to a no strings kind of relationship. Slowly, Tay begins to work her way into Cam’s heart and he starts to see the difference between his love for Bre and Tay. He tries to fight it but, after just one taste, he was a goner. Cam becomes possessive, dominant and protective of Tay.

“I just wanted to kiss you tonight before we got on the bus. That’s it. We won’t have much time alone for a while after that. And I’m going to miss touching you, tasting you and exploring every inch of you.”

“How many days are on the bus? That’s a long time.”

“No, the question is what were you doing?”

“Playing black jack like you demanded.”

“Wrong. You were letting that guy drool all over you. Five more minutes and he would have had his hand

up your shirt. I'm not jealous, but if you go within five feet of him, you'll be responsible for a premature ending to Chasing Ruin's tour."

"Tay, that feels amazing, but if don't let me inside you within the next few seconds, I don't think I'll make it to the main attraction."

This for me was a quick read, and not filled with a ton of angst. Of course their relationship was not an easy one for Cam and Tay. Tay's past is still trying to control her and she has to deal with Bre still being in Cam's life. Taylor had a crappy home life for years, and it only got worse when Alec left to pursue his dreams with Chasing Ruin. When she was able to move out on her own, she found herself trapped in a really bad relationship for several years which only added to her self esteem and self image issues. The cold back-off vibes are her version of armor in hopes of a little self preservation. She has always thought Cam is beyond hot but recognizes that a womanizer like him would be the absolute worst choice of a man to get tangled up with.

As they are forced to be together almost 24-7, things heat up rapidly between them. Cam's better qualities make an appearance and Taylor lets her guard down realizing he will probably end up hurting her in the end but deciding to give him a shot. Before they know it, they are both in way deeper than they ever thought possible in such a short time.

If I have a complaint, it would be that they fell too quickly and Cam's redemption/ turnaround came a little too easily. But it was a good quick and hot rock star read that worked nicely for me after finishing a particularly emotional read right before it and I enjoyed it.
