I think this is an alright book, but I thought it was a little too heavy on the biographical and historical details regarding Lenin's life, and not heavy enough on the theoretical elements of Marxism-Leninism. I'm not going to penalize the text too much for that, of course; because praxis is important to this branch of Marxism, I suppose it would stand to reason that one should be given concrete examples of ML in action, and one would need to see it play out in reality in order to fully comprehend it, but before one can make sense of the praxis, one needs to have a solid grasp on theory, which I hardly doubt they will after finishing this (deceptively dense) text. This text is okay, but it definitely needs to be supplemented with something else.

No doubt a sympathetic introduction to Lenin and the Russian Revolution, but I found it valuable in terms of sketching the spectrum of socialist thought at key points of Revolutionary history, and what animated Lenin to change and grow his initial ideas, and later, his policies when in government.

The narrative really focuses on Lenin and his lionish efforts in bringing about and explaining the revolution, and as a result, the human cost of War Communism is minimised. Having said that, there were interesting details about how internal the Russian economy became during the Civil War, due to blockades and international sanctions.

I don't think I could use this for all my high school students, but some sections would be highly beneficial.

This was packed with historical factoids to the effect of adding a density that belies the "for beginners" part of the title. Illustrations are amusing, particularly of Trotsky and Stalin, and well, most of the recognizable characters featured. Overall though, I feel like this is a homeless piece. It's not a comic, it's not a history text, it's not a biography. Yet, it's a cartoon-adorned work, citing primary sources describing the life and deeds of a man, while also mapping out one of the 20th century's most important events. While I was entertained by this, I'm just not sure where it fits. Probably because Book Thing.

A fantastic intro to Lenin. Really clarified and dispels a host of misconceptions and disinformation concerning this brilliant revolutionary. My only quibble with this book is that in trying to summarize Lenin and the October Revolution, it sometimes tries to do too much at once. Frequently you can just skim over minor two-line bios of Lenin's contemporaries, because they often will never appear again. Overall, though, this is a fine place to start if you want a basic understanding of Lenin and the bold, hopeful revolution he

helped create. He appears here not as an authoritarian who thirsted for power, but a true liberator who wanted to give all power to the workers and create a real workers state.

There is a mountain of ingrained propaganda concerning Lenin in the US especially, and that often manifests as equating Leninism with Stalinism. Here you will see the profound difference between the two and get a brief glimpse of Lenin's "last struggle" to end bureaucracy in the soviets and remove Stalin from General Secretary. After the revolution left Lenin and was overtaken by Stalin, that's when things deteriorated into dictatorship. If you want to know Lenin's true actions, intentions, and goals, consult this book. It's hardly exhaustive or strictly scholarly, but it's a digestible book that lays the groundwork for further investigation into this extraordinary and inspiring man. From here, I recommend advancing to Lenin's State and Revolution.

It's schizophrenic mess in parts, to be honest. I learned some interesting things about Lenin, but I don't feel like I gained much else from it. Not all bad, but I wouldn't recommend.

A good introduction to Lenin and the Russian Revolution. I found a few faults with this, though, admittedly, they may be due to my lack of background knowledge on the Russian Revolution rather than due to any error on the part of the illustrator & author.

The subject material is so dense I imagine it was a daunting task to introduce it in illustrated/comic form. The author and illustrator went through Lenin's life and therefore had to bring in tons of different and important characters from the Russian Revolution. I found myself wanting more background information and more knowledge of all the character's political views and actions- not just Lenin's. I feel it would have helped things to run a little smoother- it would have been less disjointed.

I got lost quite often in the timeline as well. The author would start 1 page with "November 2, 1904" and then 2 pages later the text would start with "March 13..." and I would find I had to flip back and forth a lot to make sure I was still in command of the year.

Definitely something I would want to read again in order to feel in command of the content. I'm not sure I would be willing to read it again though...
