I've really enjoyed watching these two meet, have a whirlwind courtship, and a fast wedding but now they are facing a lot of time apart and of course the fans, paparazzi, and fellow artists all love to spin stories about them that try and break them apart. I have been enamored with this couple since the beginning and it was really nice to see them growing, changing, and accepting their crazy life as their story continues.

I love the progression of the relationship between Hannah and Garrett and the fact that they are getting to know one another better and it's really beginning to show in their intimate moments. Hannah is truly coming in to her own not only in the bedroom but outside. While at times Garrett's temper still gets the best of him, I also see that improving especially when his family and friends are there to help him see reason. The record label is being less than honest with her and she is finding she has a voice and she can and will stand up for the life she wants. This is a very different Hannah than she was in the beginning of the series. But will the obstacles they face from their labels and those who are jealous around them, tear them from each other?

Some celebrity couple are getting a divorce, having an affair, got caught with their pants down, cheated on their significant other...it goes on and on...and it's always on the top of the news. Forget that big storm brewing or Wall Street crashing...we all want to know if they'll make it..will that Oscar winning couple survive another year of marriage, will the sneaky photogs catch someone doing something nasty on the balcony of their hotel or will our favorite singer hit #1 with their newest single....without any scandal?

Harmony and Reaper...the country music sweetheart and the bad boy rocker are newlyweds. I really felt for these two lovebirds...learning to live with (and apart from) someone you love is difficult enough, but adding the pressure of fame and politics is almost too much to handle.

This follow-up to Hannah and Garrett's first book is at times a sweet and romantic duet and at others quite brutal and filled with real-life problems that are universal for any new couple (famous or not). I found myself getting really caught up in their relationship and even when things happened that made my belly turn upside down (because I just knew it might be the end of them) I never lost hope.
