I've always been a fan of supernatural mangas and when I watched the anime for this, I knew I had to track down the manga. I have to say, it was a brilliant read. I stand by exactly what I said before. Reading this again introduced me to developments in the plot and characters that I missed before due to reading it in a fan haze. Coming to this with a much more level head was brilliant, and it really helped me to focus on the story itself more.

Atsushi is a weak character within this volume. Kunikida seems much more strong willed than in the anime. Dazai, much more cocky. Akutagawa, more powerful.

A few things I just happened to notice this read through. The artwork is not the best it could be. Some of the faces (such as Dazai's) seem a little off, and there are some frames where eyes and mouths seem to be a little bit off. Then again, I'm picky and tend to screenshot a lot of the frames and I noticed these things in hindsight. It's not immediately obvious.

There is a lot of information to take in with this volume, and the cliff hanger is a beautiful one that has me raring to read the next volume, even though I've read it once before. Beautiful, stunning, amazing, and everything else from that One Meme.

Atsushi Nakajima has just come to the city after being kicked out by his orphanage. He rescues the perpetual suicide attempter Dazai who recruits him into an armed-detective agency. They take on the mafia of the city!

So we meet Atsushi and learn about how he joins the armed-detective agency. I really liked how clueless he was about who he is and what he has been doing. The test they give him was also quite cute and a great way to meet the other detectives. Then in the end we get a major run-in with the biggest paranormal ability in the mafia! It was a good flow of plot even if the battles weren't major ones until the end.

Really though where the story shines in in the characters. I loved Dazai and his nullifying ability. That paired with his foresight and connect the dots skills and we have a great detective. The little mystery about his previous occupation was fun and kept me reading. I would like to know why he is pretending to try to kill himself because honestly when someone wants to commit suicide they are bound to succeed. The siblings were another favorite of mine, I loved the end where they defended one another!! Atsushi is a great way to get to know everyone and as he learns about the group's different abilities so do we. The president was also

super cool looking!

I'm not a fan of the mafia. If I had known they were the major villain then I probably would have passed. I'm not even a fan of the mafia in shojo manga. Still all the abilities good and evil were very interesting and the match ups were quite compelling. Also some of the battles were hard to follow, even though this was drawn recently it felt like the battle art hearkened back to the early manga where some frames have to be really interpreted.

I did enjoy the Tokyo setting and that everyone runs around with supernatural abilities. I look forward to more world building in coming volumes. Many will find the suicide attempts humorous and the by play between the characters funny. It isn't quite to my taste but is not overwhelming in the story so I was fine with reading past it.

(He tried a few times before he finally offed himself with one of his lovers) It's obvious that we will see more of this fictional Armed Detective Dazai Osamu as the series develops further.

In this world, there are people with special powers called "Skills" that vary. One character might have the ability to cancel out other people's powers, while another might have the ability to write items into being. I've seen similar powers before, but there are also some other powers that I haven't seen that keep things interesting. Not that we've seen much in the way of powers yet.

There's a group of "skilled" individuals who work as a detective agency, taking care of things the police and military can't handle (others with skills, for example), and our main character has recently gotten involved with them.

I'm not sure how to describe the main issue I ran into with this first volume. I was going to say "pacing issues," but the pacing seems okay, though not stellar. Then I was thinking emotional build up, but I don't think that's really it either. To explain would reveal some spoilers, and truth be told, I'm not sure I could explain it.
