There are tips on Buying One of These Things, plus the truth about Care and Feeding. (The trick here is knowing how much your horse weighs. Easy, really: 1. Weigh yourself. 2. Weigh yourself holding the horse. 3. Subtract 1 from 2.) And Horsekeeping Truths: A horse knows what you know. He also knows what you don't know. Written out of a lifelong love, *Hold Your Horses* gets to the heart of the passion that horses inspire. Every horsewoman will see herself in its pages.

When I was ten years old (the ideal age for someone to read this book) I found it hysterical. If I had horses, I still might find this book pretty funny. As it stands, I'm a twenty-something college graduate who does not own horses and now, *several years* after I first read it, it's not nearly as amusing. There are a couple more mature jokes in it that I totally missed when I was younger--rather like watching Disney movies as an adult. Still, this book doesn't really hold up like a Disney movie, or even like a Dr. Suess book.

If I were rating this book completely dispassionately, I would probably give it one or two stars. But I rated it from a place of nostalgia, and because my ten-year-old self would be heartbroken to hear someone rated this book that low, I gave it four stars. If you have kids who love horses, this book is for them.

And if you're an adult horse owner whose inner child is alive and well, it couldn't hurt to give this book a go.
