I have read and really enjoyed two others in Lisa's *Danger Abroad* series, Deadly Safari and Desert Secrets. This latest release though is my favourite, probably because I connected with Ellie over her near drowning as a child, and subsequent wariness of water. (Fortunately for both of us, we had someone nearby to come to our rescue!)

I love how Lisa Harris brings the world to live around her with her words so that when I read her stories I feel as though I am right there in the middle of the action – in this case travelling through the Amazon jungle and river either escaping or trying to escape from “the bad guys”.
