I loved Kimberley's Courting Trouble and was looking forward to this. Though I enjoyed it somehow it didn't live up to Trouble. There the story was solid, the romance believable and the sex sensual. Here though – the characters are great, and I enjoyed meeting Jason and Sierra again, the sex was perfect but the romance, though believable, felt stilted in the things against it, the actual story plot. It was hard to believe that two adults would really think objections against them being together when they were teens were still in effect now they're adults in their twenties. Somehow that just seemed weird, and so it spoiled the romance for me. When they were sneaking around instead of feeling sorry for them (though I did laugh at times) I was just thinking "grow up, stop acting like kids". It just didn't fit the image I had of them, especially Colton. Here we have an intelligent, very successful man – can we really believe he thinks her parents, who treat him as family, really still don't want them to be together?

If you can suspend your disbelief over the objections its a fun, sexy read. Its well written and plotted, and I love the story setting, the Luxxor connections, and the closeness of Erin's family.
