When your spaceship's been hijacked by pirates, imprisoning you and your friends, how do you cope? For Delta, there's no choice. Sold off, one by one to slavers, Delta and her friends have little hope. Changing hands time after time, she's finally sold to the barbarian ruler of Borvaan, Lord Axum. His harem is infamous across the galaxy. Escape seems impossible. Who can she trust? The palace is full of hidden intrigues and agendas. But Delta's no shrinking violet. She's determined to escape, regardless of the cost. But how? Is there any hope? Why would anyone risk their life to save her? Lord Axum may look like a frail stick of a man but he rules with an iron fist. His subjects live in absolute subservience to his whims. The members of his harem, gathered from the far reaches of the universe, are terrified of his attentions. Enter Zhynn and Zandyr, twin Tharan warriors, erstwhile ambassadors from Tharon, who've been tasked with obtaining intelligence on Borvann. But there's a hidden motive here. And little do they know what's in store for them. When Delta and the warriors connect, there's an inexplicable connection between the three, one that may prove fatal to all three. As the stakes become deadly for all concerned, Delta makes a fateful decision that just may destroy all three. With Delta's past clouding her judgment, can Zhynn and Zandyr save Delta from her own destruction? Is there any way for Delta to overcome her past, lack of trust, even herself? There's just one way out. Zandyr and Zhynn hold the key to Delta's salvation. The question is, does she have the strength to accept their help? Or will she destroy any chance of saving not only herself but the two men who hold the key to her very survival?

I started reading Kallista Dane's books on the recommendation of a friend. Once I started this series, I was hooked. *Claiming Their Mate* is the best book yet, chock full of mystery, intrigue, and, of course, hot love scenes. But beyond that, the characters are compelling. Delta's a mystery wrapped in an enigma. Her past holds her captive. At times, her doubts and fears nearly cripple her. But she's determined, feisty, and committed to escape, regardless of the odds. And while Zhynn and Zandyr are the ultimate dominants, they also have a tender side that's so alluring. They brook no insolence or defiance but also demonstrate compassion and care. It's this dichotomy to all three characters that make this story so captivating. I was hooked me from the beginning and fell in love with all three. And without the supporting characters? The story just wouldn't have worked. Neema, Lady Sylla, Commanders Rhynn and Rhom, Cass, Aliya, and even Lord Axum and his minions all add spice and ambiguity to the mix. Delta is a prisoner of a slave trader who then get sold to Lord Axum for in his harem. She gets presented to the Lord but he doesn't pick her, instead she is offered as a gift and is taken by the twin warriors Zandyr and Zhynn, who are there undercover to find out just what Lord Axum is up to but also to rescue Delta from him.

But the twins recognise Delta as their true mate, which happens rarely with their species and a human, only triggered by one special female and the right set of biological characteristics that best match their own. They have to fight their innate ability to mate with her until they can get her to safety.
