This is the first book that I have read by Lisa Suzanne. If I had paid more attention I would have read book 1 prior to reading What He Really Feels. I have to say it was fairly easy to figure out what had happened near the end of book 1, making it easier to understand where Travis was coming from in book 2.

Just when he sees that they will spend the rest of their lives together, Jules throws a wrench in his plan. Realizing that she has taken advantage of him and the close bond that they have developed after all these years of being best friends, Travis has had it. Jules has hurt him for the last time. Hoping for a clean break and a fresh start, Travis decides to head to San Diego and live with his good friend Dan and work at the firm his father has established there. But before he heads out, his buddies Mike and Bill take him out for a few more nights on the town. Just 48 hours before he is to move, Travis meets a woman at the local bar. After taking her home and experiencing the most amazing night of his life, he wants to know her more. But they had agreed to no strings, they don't even exchange names or numbers. Parting ways, he never expects to see "Gorgeous" again.

Once Travis arrives in San Diego, he gets himself settled in and gets started at his new job. He loves what he does and dives in feet first to keep his mind from wondering to his mystery woman and Jules for that matter. He finds himself thinking less and less of Jules. "Gorgeous" has taken front row to his thoughts these days. After trying unsuccessfully to date a few women that he has met since moving, he decides to confide in Dan. They have one night together but decide to not exchange real names or any info about each other. Too late, Travis realizes he wants more but Lindsay has disappeared. He doesn't think he will ever see her again. Of course, by fate she lives in San Diego and coincidentally is dating one of his new co-workers. The of course decide they are meant to be and get together. What's really different about this book is that instead of Travis being completely broken about Julianne - he takes a chance with Lindsay and recognizes her as his one true soulmate. From the events that occurred in How He Really Feels Travis is clearly hurting from what happened between him and Jules and it's CLEARLY eating him away from the inside. It's not easy loving someone for almost as long as you can remember, only to have your hopes and dreams crushed when that person doesn't feel the same way about you, or in Travis' case, chose another man over you. In all honesty I don't blame the bitterness and contempt he feels. He deserves to wallow in his misery. I feel bad for him but in the end you can't help who you like. Sure both Travis and Jules made some pretty bad choices and handled their situation poorly but that doesn't make the pain of losing someone you love any easier.

It was unusual for me to turn down any opportunity that could lead to sex, but I knew that it would be a horrible mistake for Brook and me to go there again.

Throughout most of the beginning you'll feel compelled to feel bad for Travis (if you have a heart that is). He's a good guy, sensible 95% of the time, the other 5% allotting to when 'TJ' does the thinking for him if

you catch my drift. He has a good job, comes from a good family, he's sweet, and considerable...and yet he CAN'T catch a break with women. Why is that?!

Travis reminds me of the BEST FRIEND GUY. The kinda guy who you'll have as a best friend but never date. It makes me kind of sad actually having been in a similar situation. Even before when I read part of his story in How He Really Feels I still felt bad for him. I just wanted to hug him...THROW myself at him and say TAKE ME I'M YOURS!

Literally, I cannot say enough good things about this book. At almost the halfway point I swear I wanted to throw my hands up into the air and say, I'M DONE! It's over. I can't! I'm sitting on the train...GUSHING over how cute Travis and Gorgeous are and I just want to die. I literally I just want to die. Every man should make a woman feel that loved. EVERY MAN!!! Now I'm caught between Team Nick and Team Travis and it's killing me. It's absolutely killing me.

If there's one thing Suzanne's writing is, it's compelling. I can't remember the last time I was so absorbed into a book. It's definitely one of the books you DON'T WANT TO PUT DOWN. There's a beauty in simplicity, and Suzanne definitely has it. There is definitely something about this series, this writing style that I can't find words for. There's praise, and then there's praise that you can't describe with words. I'm definitely the latter.
